Summary

Project "Equal Chance" is aimed at applying innovations in the school in the following directions:

- Develop students' critical thinking abilities and acquire the skills needed by both themselves and the community to which they belong.
- Improving communication and educational process in children with SEN.
- Improving digital competence for the needs of distance learning in electronic environment.

Challenges

Students from small communities often fall victim to their parents' inadequate attitude towards the learning process. Parents are often unaware of their children's real development and have either too high expectations or none. This disincentives students and builds a negative attitude towards the school as an institution and the learning process in particular. Placed in this position, teachers need not only to make the training attractive, but also to adapt the content for class level, taking into account the individual needs of the students.

Options

- The realization of this and similar projects are a prerequisite for:
- encourage the creativity of the teacher
 - increasing the digital literacy
 - improving teaching methods and techniques
 - opportunity to share and exchange digital educational resources
 - increase interest in the educational process

Description

The main objectives of the project:

- Access for students from a small school to modern educational resources, adapted to their needs.
- Use of ICT technologies in children with SEN for training and rehabilitation.
- Improving the qualification of teachers to develop educational resources according to the needs of the students.



- Age group of pupils: 6-14 years
- Number of students: 53
- Number of participating teachers: 10

The use of social networks, communication with peers from all over the world presuppose the formation of civil position on issues related to globalization, ecology and human rights.
